<sup>(1)</sup> Transfer students who transfer fewer than 64 semester credits are required to take two speaking-intensive courses. One speaking intensive course can be transferred to Hamline; one must be taken at Hamline. Students transferring as juniors (64 or more semester credits) are required to take only one speaking-intensive course, but it must be taken at Hamline.

<sup>(2)</sup> The MnTC requires two courses in the natural sciences with at least one having a lab, while the Hamline Plan requires 2 natural sciences courses with labs. If we had free-standing lab courses, the present proposal would include requiring the 2<sup>nd</sup> lab course of all transfer students. Because we do not have such free-standing lab courses, the present proposal is to waive the 2<sup>nd</sup> lab for transfer students who have satisfied the MnTC Goal 3, since doing otherwise would have the effect of imposing a requirement of 3 natural science classes on transfer students, a more demanding requirement than the Hamline Plan imposes on those who begin with us as first-year students.

<sup>(3)</sup> Cultural breadth will require three separate courses, from at least two different categories. If one course covers two different categories, it may only be used to satisfy one cultural breadth requirement.

<sup>(4)</sup> Goal area 9 and goal area 10 may count towards goal areas 3 and 5-8 depending on course/subject.
